## THE ARTISTS



A native of Shanghai, China, violinist **Lun Li** won First Prize in the 2021 Young Concert Artists Susan Wadsworth International Auditions, as well as The Paul A. Fish Memorial Prize and The Buffalo Chamber Music Society Prize, and was named John French Violin Chair at YCA. He is also the recent joint winner of First Prize at the Lillian and Maurice Barbash J.S. Bach Competition.

Traveling between Shanghai and Philadelphia has brought him experience and honor. In 2012, as a result of winning the second place of the 2nd Haydn Chamber Competition in Shanghai, his quartet was invited to perform in Helsinki Music Centre Festival. He has participated in masterclasses with Arnold Steinhardt, Midori Goto and Pierre Amoyal. In 2017, he served as the concertmaster of the Pacific Festival Orchestra under the conductor Valery Gergiev. His festival appearances include Marlboro Music Festival, Music@Menlo, Music from Angel Fire, and Verbier Festival Academy.

Mr. Li recently graduated from the Curtis Institute of Music with a bachelor's degree under the tutelage of Ida Kavafian, and was a recipient of the Jean J. Sterne fellowship. Mr. Li is now pursuing a master's degree at the Juilliard School with Catherine Cho and Joseph Lin. <https://yca.org/artist/li-lun/>.



Pianist **Ying Li**, from China, entered the Curtis Institute of Music in Philadelphia in 2012 and currently studies with Professor Jonathan Biss. Ms. Li attends on a merit-based, full-tuition scholarship, and holds the Harold and Helene Schonberg Fellowship. As a soloist, Ms. Li has appeared with numerous orchestras including her most recent debut with the New Jersey Symphony Orchestra. She has also worked with the Longwood Symphony Orchestra, the Brevard Music Center Orchestra, the St. Petersburg Chamber Philharmonic Orchestra, and the "Mihail Jora" Philharmonic Orchestra of

Romania. She has garnered several awards, among them: First Prize in the Artist Series of Sarasota National Competition, First Prizes of both the Solo Competition and Concerto Competition of the Brevard Music Festival, First Prize in the 7th Liszt International Competition for Young Pianists in Moscow, and the First Prize and the audience prize in the 7th International Competition for Young Pianists 'A Step Towards Mastery' in St. Petersburg, Russia.

Ms. Li began receiving piano lessons at age five. Her teachers have included Seymour Lipkin, from the Curtis Institute of Music in Philadelphia and Manchun Chen, from the Central Conservatory of Music in China. <https://imfchicago.org/events/ying-li/>
